ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER / COACH / MANAGER)

- 1) All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- 2) No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
- 3) No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letter head.
- 4) No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- 5) In case of Girls participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.

The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.

- 6) No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises.
- 7) Departure after Prize Distribution Around time 5:30 pm on 29/10/2023.

General / Mandatory Instructions

- 1) Taking part in Opening ceremony, march past & closing ceremony is mandatory for all school and players.
- 2) Escort Coach / Manager shall be held responsible for their student's behaviour and of use of language. The same shall be reported to their school Principal / Management.
- 3) At time of event in progress only participating student shall be entitled to enter in playing arena.
- 4) It is mandatory for all coaches/managers/players to wear school identify card during days of meet irrespective they are in or out of school campus.
- 5) It is mandatory for all the schools to deposit total amount for all the days of competition as per CBSE norms at the time of reporting.
- 6) Students movement after 10:00 P.M. outside their accommodation room is shall not be allowed.
- 7) It is mandatory for all coaches & Managers to stay with students is allowed accommodation on room.
- 8) Bringing or use of tobacco sachets, cigarettes, and liquor is strictly prohibited in school campus. If any coach / manager / student is found drunk or smoking in campus, his / her team shall be disqualified with immediate effect and same will be informed to their principal.
- 9) Only Veg.meals will be served in school campus.
- 10) The host school shall not be responsible for any incident happens out of school campus during outing of any coach/manger/team or players.
- 11) **School each team have to bring 2 Chess set and 2 DGT chess clock well labelled with school name & school code.**

ELIGIBILITY

Age: _____

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

- (a) Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- (b) A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- (c) Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- (d) Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- (e) The original eligibility Performa of the Athletes/Players/Teams qualifying to participate from Cluster/Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at the Cluster / Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, immediately after their Cluster/Zone level competition is over.
- (f) Medical check-up may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion/ protest.
- (g) A player shall be under 11; 14; 17; & 19 years of age as on 31 Dec of the year of event. Accordingly, for session 2018-19 sports events, the age criteria will be as follows:
 - 1. Under 11 years: Born on or after 01.01.2013
 - 2. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2010
 - 3. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2007
 - 4. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2005
- (h) All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation. The participants must be physically present for reporting one day prior to the commencement of the event.
- (i) The players right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

Any team / athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament / meet shall not be permitted to participate.

IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE-

- (i) The documents for verification in original if asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (iii) To supply the eligibility Performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (iv) The Eligibility/Entry Performa in disciplines like Athletics, Judo & Swimming shall include the event/weight category in which the athlete wishes to participate.

CHESS RULES

(BOYS, GIRLS AND MIXED TEAM)

- 1) Rules of the All India Chess Federation and FIDE shall apply to the Inter-School Chess tournament with modifications wherever applicable.**
- 2) The team championship will be held in under 11, 14, 17 & 19 years age category in both the sections i.e. Boys, Girls and Mixed.**
- 3) Every school that wishes to participate is entitled to field the following four teams. The constitution of team members shall be:**
 - (i) Under 11 years Mixed Category: Either only Boys" or Boys" & Girls" mixed team**
 - (ii) Under 11 years Girls Category: Only Girls" as team members**
 - (iii) Under 14 years Mixed Category: Either only Boys" or Boys" & Girls" mixed team**
 - (iv) Under 14 years Girls Category: Only Girls" as team members.**
 - (v) Under 17 years Mixed Category: Either only Boys" or Boys" & Girls" mixed team**
 - (vi) Under 17 years Girls Category: Only Girls" as team members.**
 - (vii) Under 19 years Mixed Category: Either only Boys" or Boys & Girls mixed team**
 - (viii) Under 19 years Girls Category: Only Girls as team members**
- 4) The tournament will be played according to the Swiss System (Seven/Six Rounds). A team shall not play against any other team more than once.**
- 5) A team may consist of a maximum of 04 players (With no reserve). Each playing against the other of the same status in order of ranking.**
- 6) Each school shall clearly state the names of its team members before the start of the tournament. Captain/Manager shall submit the original ranking order to the Chief Arbiter before the start of the tournament.**
- 7) Each team must play through the entire tournament. However, if a team is forced by circumstances beyond its control to withdraw from the tournament, the team/s will not be paired for the remaining matches.**
- 8) The session of play shall be of 40 moves in 90 minutes followed by 30 minutes sudden death rule. In case of availability of Digital Clocks in absolute numbers the time control shall be 90 minutes for the entire with 30 seconds increment from move one.**
- 9) Scoring system: The team winning the match will be awarded „2" points and losing team „0". In case of draw, both the teams will be awarded " 1 " point each. For example, teams winning by 4 - 0; 3½ - ½; 3 - 1 or 2½ - 1½, will be awarded „2" points, irrespective of their score.**
- 10) The final positions of teams shall be determined by the number of points scored by each team.**
- 11) The position of teams, which finish with the same number of game points, shall be determined by the application of the following tie-breaking procedures, in sequence from (a) to (b) to (c) to (d) to the extent required.**
 - (a) By the sum of the game scores of all the teams' opponents.**
 - (b) By the sum of match points won.**
 - (c) By the sum of the game of all the opponents defeated plus one half of the game scores of all the opponents with which tied result was achieved.**
 - (d) By the sum of the game scores of all the team's opponents, excluding the opponents who scored the highest number of game points and the opponent who scored the lowest number of game point.**

- 12) For breaking the tie for Board Prizes; the higher placed team member will be considered for Board Prize.
- 13) What-so-ever the circumstance is, request pertaining to postponement of first round will not be entertained.
- 14) The walk-over time shall be 15 minutes.
- 15) Each team while sending their eligibility Performa will also confirm in writing that they will bring two Chess clocks and two Chess sets, along with them.
- 16) Board Prize Winners will be awarded only the Merit Certificates. (No Medals).
- 17) The members of teams winning "Team & Individual Championships" will be awarded Merit Certificates & Medals.
- 18) From each Zone, following team shall qualify to participate in Nationals:
 - a) Under 11 Age Group – Top 2 team in both categories
 - b) Under 14 Age Group – Top 2 team in both categories
 - c) Under 17 Age Group – Top 2 team in both categories
 - d) Under 19 Age Group – Top 2 team in both categories
- 19) At National level the third day of the championship shall be dedicated exclusively to the individual championship.
- 20) The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at /National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
