## SPECTRUM ( Rang Tarng Umang )

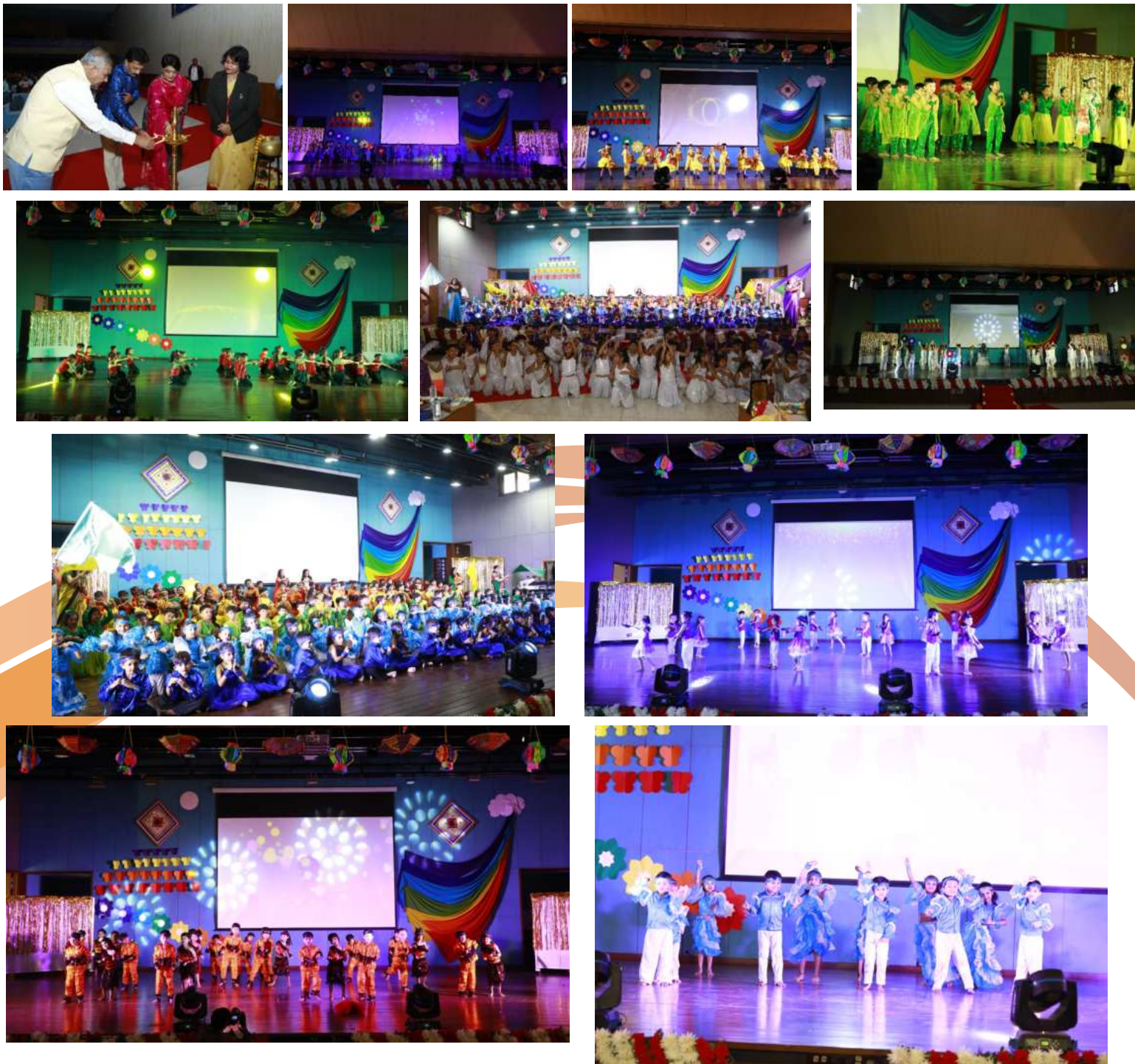
