NURSERY - MAGIC LETTER PAINTINGS

Magic letters activity – wax resist art. This is a crayon resist activity, meaning you paint on top of the crayon.

Here's how to set it up: Take your white crayon and write letters all over the paper. White on white makes them hard to see.

When you hand your child the paper, they won't see a thing on it!

With this magic letter activity, first letters appear out of nowhere!

A fun way to use crayon wax resist art to introduce your toddler to first letters.

As they paint over the paper the letters magically appear and your child will become more familiar with their shapes and numbers.

In this activity, children can learn letters and alphabets through a fun manner, with an element of surprise.

Our spin on the classic crayon resist is a fun way to learn letters by magically making them appear when painting the paper.

Developing fine motor skills in childhood is essential if a child is to learn to hold a crayons. There is more value in doing pre-writing

Magic painting is good practice for building hand-eye coordination, an important aspect of physical development.
