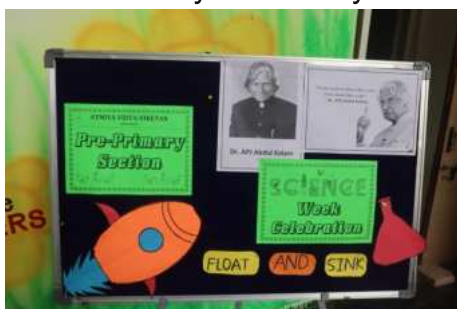

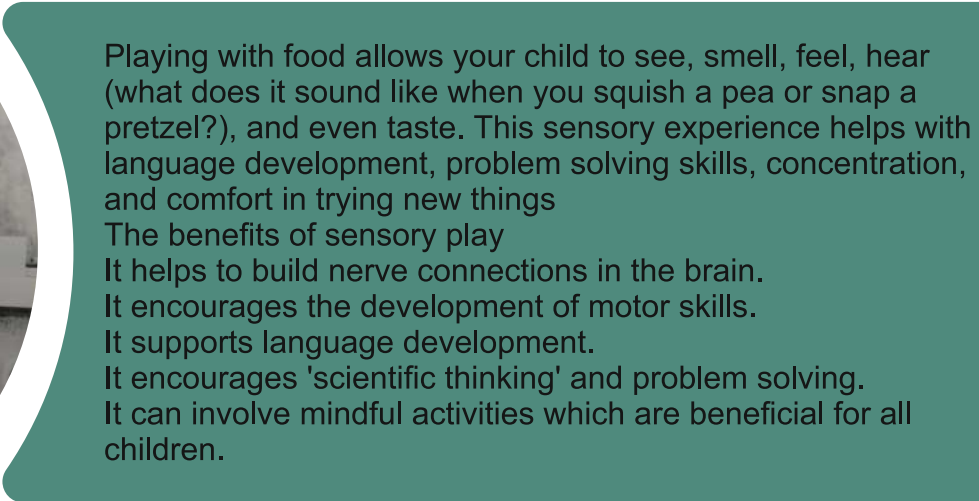

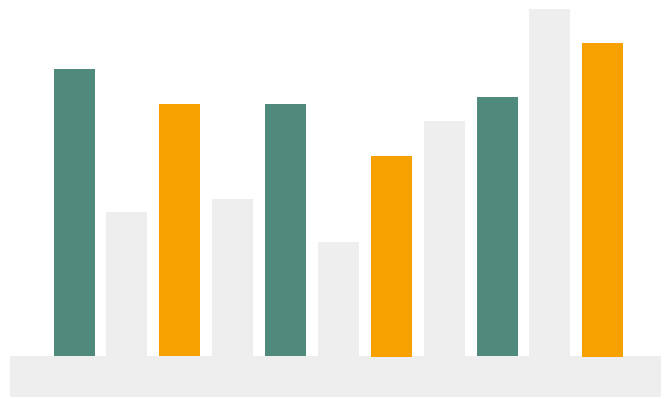


MAGIC LETTER PAINTINGS

Our spin on the classic crayon resist is a fun way to learn letters by magically making them appear when painting the paper. Developing fine motor skills in childhood is essential if a child is to learn to hold a crayons. There is more value in doing pre-writing
