ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of endeavour of our institution. The 2024-25 session began with great enthusiasm and spirit, marked by new plans and ventures. The school now has a total strength of 1,246 students, ranging from Nursery to Class 12, supported by 74 teaching staff and 10 non-teaching staff members.

We feel elated to share that the students of class X, and XII who appeared for Secondary and Higher Secondary Examination held by CBSE for Session 2022-23, passed with flying colours.

The school proudly celebrates the success of the fourth batch of **Class X students** (2023-24), who achieved a remarkable 100% pass rate.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

A WINNING EFFORT BEGINS WITH PREPARATION. Apart from the curriculum, various external examinations were conducted in the school which helps our students to excel and prepare them to compete with a healthy spirit. Science Olympiad and Silver Zone Olympiad examinations for various subjects were conducted. The results of Olympiad Examinations are
