Out of which 37 of them received gold medals, 30 silver medals, and 28 bronze medals.80 students of Atmiya Vidya Niketan Ahmedabad got selected for Rangotsav International Level Competition. It is an honour for me to deliver that Master

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Sulakshya Nagta of class 4B is the topper of the school & bagged 1 bicycle & **'Young Artist Award'**. Total 7 students received the Young Artist Award.

The Principle received the **Indian Art and Culture Award** as a mark of love and respect from the Rangotsav Celebration. Mr. Manish Bajaniya of the Art and Craft Department received the **Indian Arts Mark Award** for his valuable efforts in conducting the competition. Above all, the school has also received the award of '**The Highest Performing School in the World**'.

The students of Atmiya Vidya Niketan Ahmedabad participated in Divine Fest, an Interschool Competition hosted by The Divine Child International School, Adalaj. A total of 28 participants took part in the competition. In debate competition Master Hiren Gohel got the third position as an interjector.

Raghav Agarwal from class 12 (Commerce) participated in the IIMUN (India's International Movement to Unite Stations) conference held in Ahmedabad. I.I.M.U.N. (India's International Movement to Unite Nations, also known as the *Indian International Model United Nations or IIMUN*) a youth organization. At the IIMUN conference, he won the award for best delegate.

SPORTS ACHIEVEMENT

There goes a good proverb – All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy. Games and sports are not only important in school but also very much essential for success in every walk of our life. The AVNITES trained under the expert coaches for various sports activities like cricket, Kabaddi, Karate, Chess, Table Tennis, Skating, Football and recreational games as a part of their curriculum. This year the students took part in various level of sports competition and brought laurel to the school. The sports achievements are

- Our primary students participated in CBSE West Zone Chess tournament. AVN school got 16th rank among 27 schools. Swar Patel of class 4 B got 5th Place in the competition.
- Gujarat State Wado Karate Championship 2022 was organized by Wado-Kai-Karate-Do Federation of India at Adalaj, Gandhinagar on 25 December 2022.

20 students from AVN among 650 participants from Gujarat State have participated. 16 out of 20 players won medals – including 3 Gold, 4 Silver and 9 Bronze.

Students from Atmiya Vidya Niketan competed in the Gujarat government's Khel-Mahakumbh and won prizes in various events. Bhumika Mahecha from commerce class 11 won first place in Ranip ward and the west zone, as well as third place in the Ahmedabad district, in the athletic shot-put event. She was also awarded a cash prize of 1,000 rupees. At the district level, Hetvi Jadwani from class 9 came in third place in karate and was awarded a monetary prize of Rs.1000. In Ranip Ward and West Zone, boys under 17 won the first position in the tug of war.

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EDUCATIONAL TOURS & FIELD TRIPS

Nothing beats an exciting hand—on experience to deepen learning. The magic of a field trip isn't just the subject. It's the break in routine and adventure that opens up children's minds to new things. Educational tours and field trips allow children to get away from their daily routines and learn something new. It is all about having learning experiences that inspire.

The Pre-primary section visited Reliance Mall, Shahibaug, Gandhi Ashram, Kankaria Zoo & Traffic Park. Through these visits the students learnt the value of the nature around us and also got trained to value it in real life.

The primary section has visited Parle-G, Sundarvan, Gandhi Ashram, Amul Dairy and ISRO for the educational trips when they got the experience of practical knowledge.

The educational field trips done by secondary and higher sections were My FM 94.3, Amul Diary, ISRO, and Ravi Shankar Raval Kala Bhavan: The Biggest Wild Life Photography and Art Exhibition by 45 Elite Wild Life Enthusiasts.

A one-day picnic was organized for pre-primary section and class 1 at Shanti Suman Resort near Sanand, for classes 2 to 8 at Camp Dilly near Anand, the students explored various activities, including adventures, games, and fun dance, which they enjoyed to the fullest as it was a break from their daily school routine.

An educational trip was conducted for classes VII–12 to Goa. This educational trip beyond the walls of their classroom helped develop their inquiry into the importance of rich heritage through the wonderful archive collected and maintained in the museum. It was a great platform for the students to learn teamwork, time management, independence, leadership skills, effective learning from real-world experience, and communication skills among themselves.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES FOR TEACHERS AND STUDENTS.

Enrichment activities are not only for student, but also for teachers plays crucial role. For the holistic development of the child and upliftment of teachers' knowledge needed to be brushed-up on a regular basis.

Throughout the academic year, various seminars, workshops, and orientation programmes were held for both teachers and students, with the goal of improving and effectively implementing innovative ideas in teaching and learning practices while also pushing students beyond their current level of learning.

We have organized a career counselling session for the students of classes IX–XII. Workshops on the topics Etiquette, and good manners for classes 6 to 8 and effective time management for classes 9 to 12 were organized.

The two-day workshop on ACP (Awakened Citizen Program) for teachers was conducted in our school in the month of April. From all over Gujarat, 51 schools have participated in the workshop. The Awakened Citizen Program is a three year graded value education program for students of upper primary and Secondary level is being run in collaboration with Ramkrishna Mission. This year, we have started the ACP programme for classes 6 to 8 to develop physical and emotional aspects, teach manners and develop a sense of brotherhood, in still a spirit of patriotism, and develop religious tolerance in students.

CO CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Holistic development essentially means intellectual, physical, emotional, and social development, which can be achieved only through proper education. Therefore, education plays a fundamental role in holistic development. Co-curricular activities help develop students' holistic development and help them achieve 21st-century skills. As a result, the value of extracurricular activities during school is enormous.

From pre-primary to higher secondary sessions, a variety of co-curricular activities were held, including Hindi Diwas, English Enigma Day, Science Week Eureka 2022, Social Science Week etc. Through different club activities the students have been given the exposure of debate, public speaking, Reading, Theatre etc.

Me and My super hero -cooking without fire competition was organized for Pre primary tiny tots along with their fathers to develop and strengthen their bond as well as introducing them to a life skill.
